5 melted. Instead there were little chips of chocolate throughout the cookies.


Popsicles:

In 1905, an 11-year-old Frank Epperson was mixing powdered soda and water to make soda pop. He accidentally left the mixing bucket outside, and overnight the mixture froze solid, with the <u>6 stirrer</u> standing up. But the frozen pop tasted great! Frank started selling "Epperson Ticicles," later known as <u>8 Popsicles</u>.
