Ice cream cones :

Ernest Hamwi was selling Syrian pastry at the St. Louis World's ①Fair in 1904. When a nearby ice-cream ②vendor ③ran out of dishes, Hamwi rolled some pastry into a cone so that ice cream could be put inside. It was a hit.

Chocolate chip cookies:

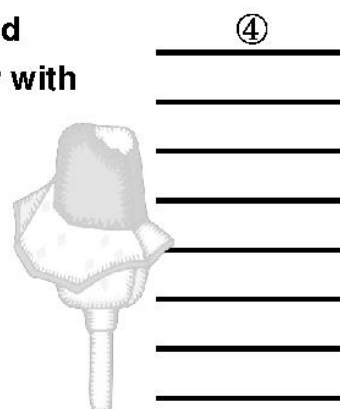
In 1930, Ruth Wakefield was making chocolate cookies. When she ran out of baking chocolate, Wakefield broke a bar of semi-sweet chocolate into pieces and added them to the ④dough. When the cookies were baked, the chocolate hadn't ⑤melted. Instead there were little chips of chocolate throughout the cookies.

Popsicles:

In 1905, an 11-year-old Frank Epperson was mixing powdered soda and water to make soda pop. He accidentally left the mixing bucket outside, and overnight the mixture froze solid, with the ⑥stirrer standing up. But the frozen pop tasted great! Frank started selling "Epperson ⑦icicles," later known as ⑧Popsicles.
